- o Flashlight with extra batteries
- o Rain gear (if needed)
- o Pillow and sleeping bag or bedding
- o Medications in original containers in a labeled zip-lock bag to be handed over to be the responsibility of your adult sponsors from your church. Please put your name on all medications and medical devices.

Be sure to clearly mark all of your belongings with your name.

Do not bring laptops, iPads, video gaming systems, iPods/MP3, DVD players, candy or food (as they may attract pests), weapons of any kind, fireworks, alcohol, tobacco or vaping products, or valuables. (Camp Kum-Ba-Ya is not responsible for damaged, lost or stolen items.) Note: Campers WILL BE sent home before the end of the event if weapons, fireworks, illegal drugs, alcohol, vaping or tobacco products are found.
